#1108309 Defendant Efren Valencia convicted on February 2, 2007, of assault with a deadly weapon, elder abuse, and causing great bodily injury after a three day jury trial before Judge Murphy-Begen. During trial, Valencia acted as his own attorney, refused to attend all the proceedings, waived his right to a probation report and demanded he be sentenced immediately. He received fifteen years in state prison with a maximum of 15% credits.

#1042467 Defendants James Lynn Bartlett and Gregory Norsworthy were both sentenced to state prison in Dept 5 before Judge Begen after being convicted July 15th, 2005 by a jury of various felony charges that left the victim paralyzed from the neck down. Bartlett received 33 yrs 8 mos and Norsworthy received 158 years to life.

#1076152 Defendant Felix Lopez held to answer on charges of murder, gang and firearms allegations after a multi-day preliminary hearing in Dept. 9 before Judge Steffen. Next court appearance is set for February 14th, 2007 in Dept 9.

#1216264 Defendant Esteban Magana Nepita set for jury trial on January 30th, 2007 in Dept 8 before Judge Cordova on misdemeanor spousal abuse charges. Case was dismissed when victim couldn't be located to testify at trial.

#1214660 Defendant Jose Omar Gutierrez set for jury trial January 30th in Dept. 4 before Judge Johnson. Trial vacated when defendant was convicted of felony spousal abuse after the judge indicated he would sentence him to sixty-seven days in jail if he pleaded guilty.

#1211735 Defendant Robert Lewis set for jury trial in Dept. 4 before Judge Johnson on misdemeanor battery charges. Case dismissed after victim couldn't be located to testify at trial.

#1096510 Defendant Toni Rachelle Mason set for felony jury trial on January 30th, 2007. Trial was vacated after defendant pleaded guilty to misdemeanor possession of stolen property in Dept 11 before Judge Salter. Defendant was sentenced to the court's previously indicated offer of 45 days in jail and misdemeanor probation.

#1209704 Defendant Paul Grady Hardin set for jury trial in Dept 2 before Judge Silveira on charges of misdemeanor hit and run and driving on a suspended or revoked license for DUI. Trial vacated when defendant pleaded as charged based upon Judge's indicated sentence of 60 days in jail, which the People had opposed.

#1212698 Defendant Alfredo Villagomes Vigil set for jury trial in Dept 2 before Judge Silveira on charges of drunk driving with two prior convictions for drunk driving and

driving on a suspended or revoked driver's license with prior convictions for doing the same. Trial vacated when defendant pleaded guilty to the drunk driving charge and driving on a suspended or revoked license for the agreed upon disposition of 4 months in jail, probation and \$2,541 in fines.

#1222226 Defendant Anna Walker was arraigned January 30th, 2007 on felony charges of child molest, unlawful sexual intercourse with a minor, twelve counts of child endangerment, and one count of furnishing alcohol to a minor and bail was set at \$250,000.00. Next court appearance is set for February 5th, 2007 in Dept. 4 before Judge Johnson.

#1209616 Defendant: Jesus Balderrama set for jury trial in Dept 6 before Judge Ashley on felony charges of possession of stolen property. Trial date was vacated due to defense counsel being unavailable. Case next on for Monday February 5th for re-setting of jury trial.

#1211194 Defendant Cheryl Mahoney set for jury trial in Dept 2 before Judge Silveira on misdemeanor charges of driving under the influence of a drug. Trial was vacated because defense attorney was unavailable. Case next set for February 8th for setting of a new jury trial date.
