#1230710 Defendant Ricardo Enciso Rodriguez. Set for jury trial November 6th in Department 7 before Judge Shaver on felony charges of Assault With a Deadly Weapon. Trial date vacated on November 1st in Department 2 before Judge Silveira, after, over the People's objection, the Court granted a defense motion to suspend the proceedings so the defendant could be examined for competency by a psychologist. The defendant had been evaluated two-and-a-half months earlier. The next court date is December 6th in Department 7 to review the doctor's report.
