Modesto, California - Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that Lamarr Marquis Oldham, age 27, of Modesto, has been convicted of First Degree Murder along with an enhancement for using a firearm. Deputy District Attorney Tracy Roland represented the People during this proceeding.

Oldham and co-defendant Isaiah James Stafford were both charged in the December 2013 murder of Damian Villavicencio. On Monday, April 2nd, Oldham pled guilty before Judge Ricardo Cordova in Department 8 of the Stanislaus County Superior Court. Oldham admitted on the record in open court that he was helping Stafford rob the victim at the time and that he personally fired a handgun.

Sentencing for Oldham will occur after disposition of co-defendant Stafford's case which is expected to go to jury trial in 2019. It is expected that Oldham will receive 25-years to life in state prison for his role in the murder plus an additional ten years in prison for personally using a firearm.
